STJB Parent Information Sheet

<u>RECORDS:</u> For recording purposes, the Church must obtain all Sacramental certificates. You must provide this at the time of registration.

MASS ATTENDANCE CARDS: Participation in mass is part of the curriculum, along with in-person classes. Students are required to have an authorized person sign this Mass Attendance Log each week. The Mass Card MUST be submitted to teacher on/before due date

<u>DRESS CODE FOR CLASSES</u>: Dresses and shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee. Dress sleeves must be 3 fingers wide in width. Shoes must always be worn. No sagging pants. No hats or hoodies.

CONTACT INFORMATION AND FORMS: IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT YOU KEEP ALL CONTACT INFORMATION AND FORMS UPDATED, FOR HEALTH AND SAFETY ISSUES.

Class Cell Phone Policy

Purpose: To have the student's total attention during class time, and to avoid interruption of learning.

Policy: Students are permitted to possess a cell phone; however, <u>must be turned off and placed in provided (labeled) envelopes.</u> The envelopes will be placed in a covered container, on the teacher's desk. There will be a cell phone log that students, will sign in and out. The teacher will give the cell phones back at the end of class. Students caught violating this policy, will have consequences. They are as follows:

First Violation:

The student will receive a verbal warning to turn in cell phone.

Second Violation:

Phone will be picked up by the teacher and given to the parent at time of pick up.

Third Violation:

Student will no longer be allowed to bring cell phone to class.

Disclaimer:

St. John Berchmans Catechism Program is not responsible for the loss,

theft, or damage to any cell phone. Student may want to consider

leaving their cell phones at home or with parents.

<u>ATTENDANCE:</u> Anyone with unexcused absences may be held back or dismissed from the program. A doctor's excuse is needed for absence to be excused. Class begins promptly. Tardiness will not be tolerated.

MAKE UP WORK: Class make-up work will be given at the discretion of the teacher. It is ultimately the responsibility of the student, to make up any missed work.

<u>CLASS CANCELLATION</u>: In the event of an emergency or last-minute cancellation, it is imperative that parents keep teachers updated with correct email and phone numbers.

<u>DISCIPLINE:</u> Teachers should and will be respected at all times. Anyone who does not follow classroom and program rules will be dismissed from the program. The teachers are dedicated, committed, volunteering their time and energy, and should be respected at all times. Parents will be notified of any disruptive behaviors.

<u>PARENT INVOLVEMENT</u>: We encourage parent involvement for any Church event. However, all adults wanting to volunteer, will need to participate in the Safe Environment Training Program. Please contact the Church Office.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

Students are expected to follow all rules during class time, retreats, and events. Students may be suspended or removed from the St. John Berchmans Catechism Program for failure to abide by rules.

STUDENTS MUST:
